On highways, when you see emergency vehicles with activated lights in an adjacent lane—you must *MOVE OVER* one lane (if you can do so safely). If it's not safe to move over, you must *SLOW DOWN*.

# COLORADO'S MOVE OVER LAW

Colorado's *Move Over* law protects law enforcement, fire, maintenance and other emergency personnel.

When approaching stopped or slow-moving emergency vehicles with activated red, white, or blue lights in an adjacent lane you must:

**MOVE OVER** one lane when traveling on a road with two or more lanes in the same direction;

**SLOW DOWN** and use caution when traveling on a road with only one lane in each direction.



Failing to obey the *Move Over* law is a careless driving offense which can result in a minimum \$150 fine and a four-point penalty on your license.
