



JOB ANNOUNCEMENT PART-TIME FIREFIGHTER/EMT

The Basalt & Rural Fire Protection District and Snowmass-Wildcat Fire Protection District are currently seeking part-time Firefighter/EMTs, paramedic certification preferred. These two fire districts that are merging into one fire authority to serve two unique communities bound by a shared passion to serve, a dedication of excellence, respect for diversity, and a commitment to our communities. Successful applicants can expect to work in both Districts until consolidation into a fire authority on January 1, 2019.

Firefighter/EMT and Firefighter/Paramedic:

Under supervision, the position is responsible for EMS & Fire Service delivery to the town of Snowmass Village, the town of Basalt, and surrounding areas; this includes: fire suppression, hazardous material response, rescue operation and basic & advanced life support emergency medical services. A well-qualified applicant would be an experienced Firefighter and Emergency Medical Technician with the appropriate certifications as listed.

Single Role Paramedic

Under supervision, the position is responsible for emergency medical services delivery to the town of Snowmass Village, the town of Basalt, and surrounding areas; this includes: basic & advanced life support EMS. A well-qualified applicant would be a Paramedic with the appropriate certifications as listed.

Minimum Qualifications:

FIREFIGHTER/EMT

Candidates **must** have the following minimum qualifications:

- A) High School Diploma or GED
- B) A valid State of Colorado driver's license (or ability to obtain in 30 days)
- C) Valid Colorado EMT or National Registry EMT certification or higher
- D) Valid Colorado or IFSAC or Pro-Board Firefighter I certificate or higher
- E) Hazardous Materials Operations certificate and ability to obtain a Colorado Hazmat Operations
- F) Valid S-130/190, ICS 100, 200 and ICS 700 (within 12 months of hire) certificate

**If certifications are not valid in Colorado, must be able to obtain Colorado certifications within one (1) year of hire.
